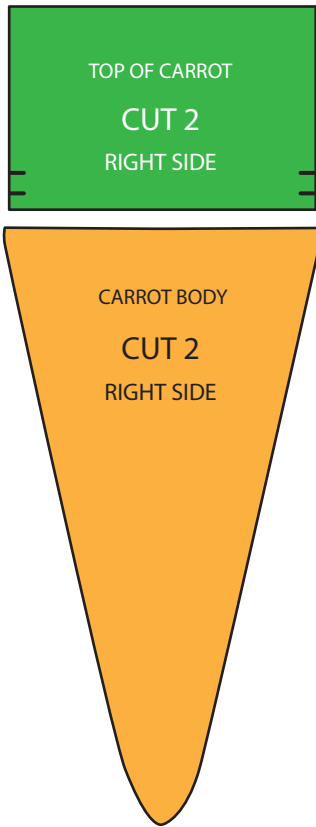
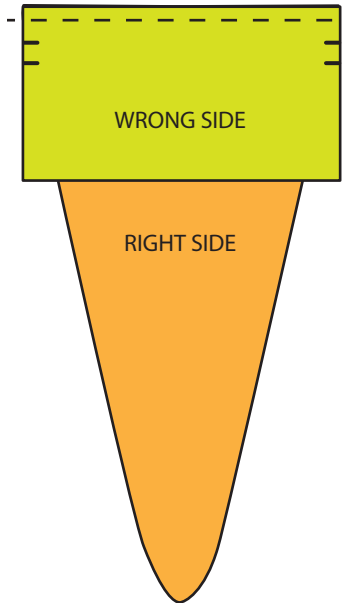


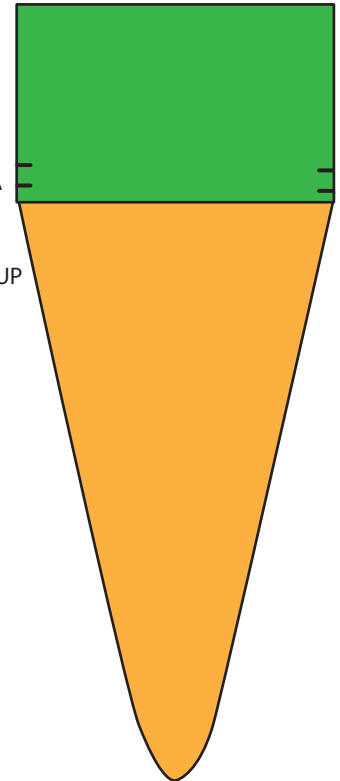
Carrot Candy Bag



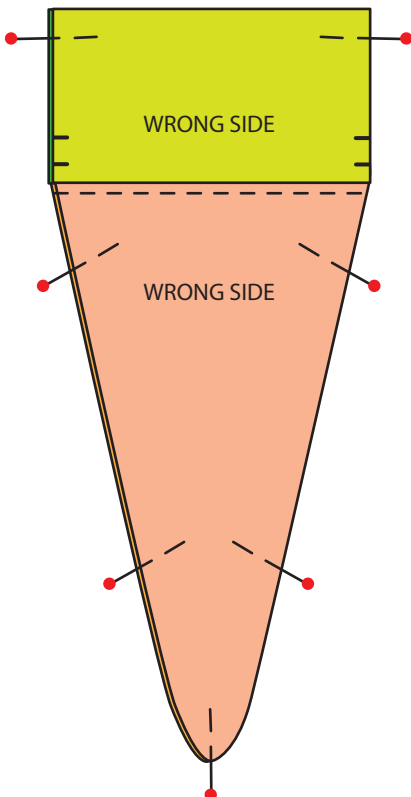
1. With right sides together, sew top of carrot (green) to carrot body (orange) with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Make two.



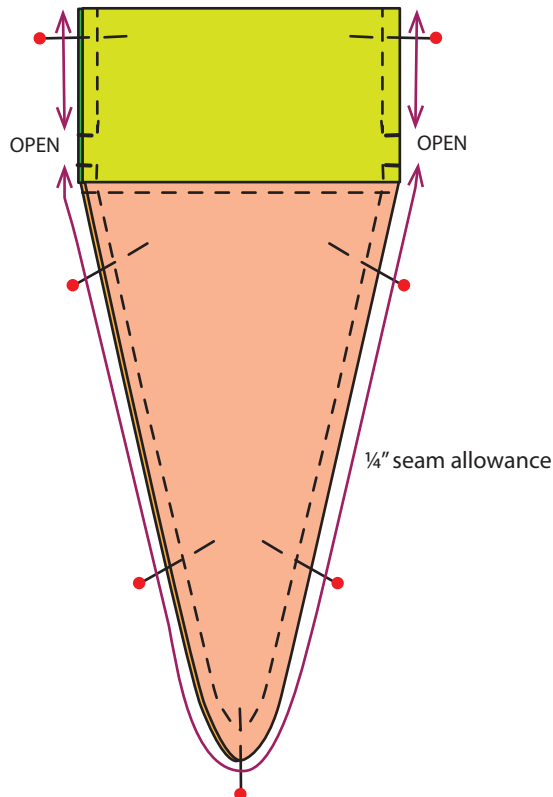
press seam allowance UP into green



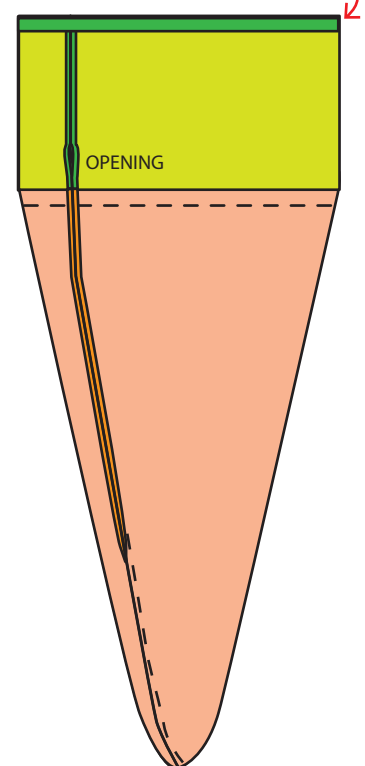
2. Layer the carrot/top pieces, right sides together and raw edges lined up. Pin the sides.



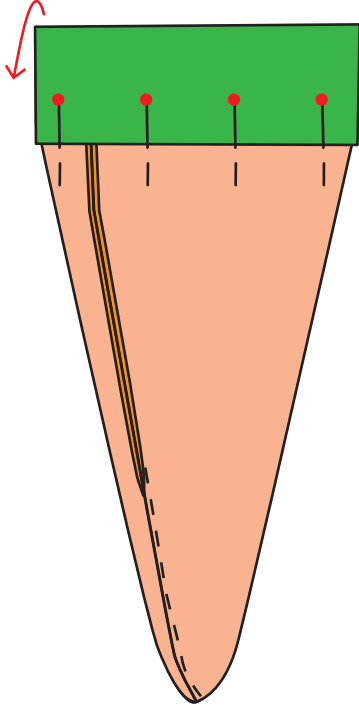
4. Starting at the top edge of the carrot top, sew to the first mark, backstitch, and clip the thread. Starting at the second mark with a backstitch, sew around the bottom of carrot and back up finishing at the mark on the opposite side, stop and backstitch. Then sew from the next mark to the top of the carrot top finishing with a backstitch.



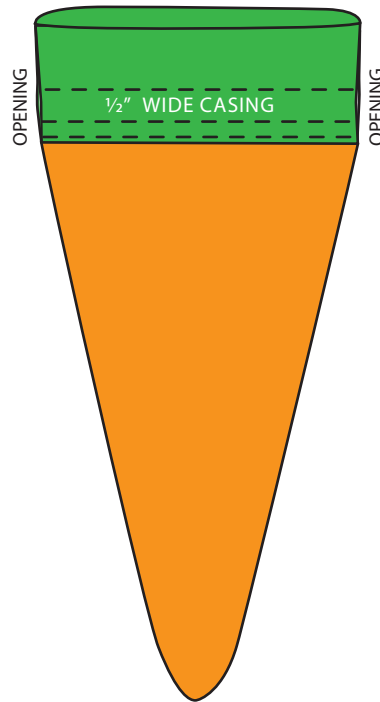
5. Press side seam allowances open. Fold the top edge down $\frac{1}{4}$ " to wrong side and press.



6. Fold the carrot top down so the turned-under edge covers the row of stitching and seam allowance. Pin in place.



7. Turn the bag right side out and press. Top stitch carrot top to carrot, 1/8" from edge, catching all seam allowances. Mark the stitch lines for the drawcord casing. Stitch around the carrot top to create the casing.



DRAWCORDS

Cut 2 drawcords 1" x 19" of green fabric.

Make drawstring: fold the strips in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press the fold.



Unfold and turn the raw edges of the strip into the center crease; press.



Fold again, on center crease and press.

Topstitch along the edge of the length of drawstring. Make 2 drawstrings: 1/4" x 19"



8. Attach a safety pin or bodkin to one end of the ribbon. Insert pin into casing opening. Thread ribbon through casing, out the other side and back in through back casing to the opening where you started. Repeat the process starting on the opposite side of the bag, using another piece of ribbon.

Tie knots at the ends of the ribbons
Fill with candy or goodies.
Tug on both ribbons to cinch the bag closed.
